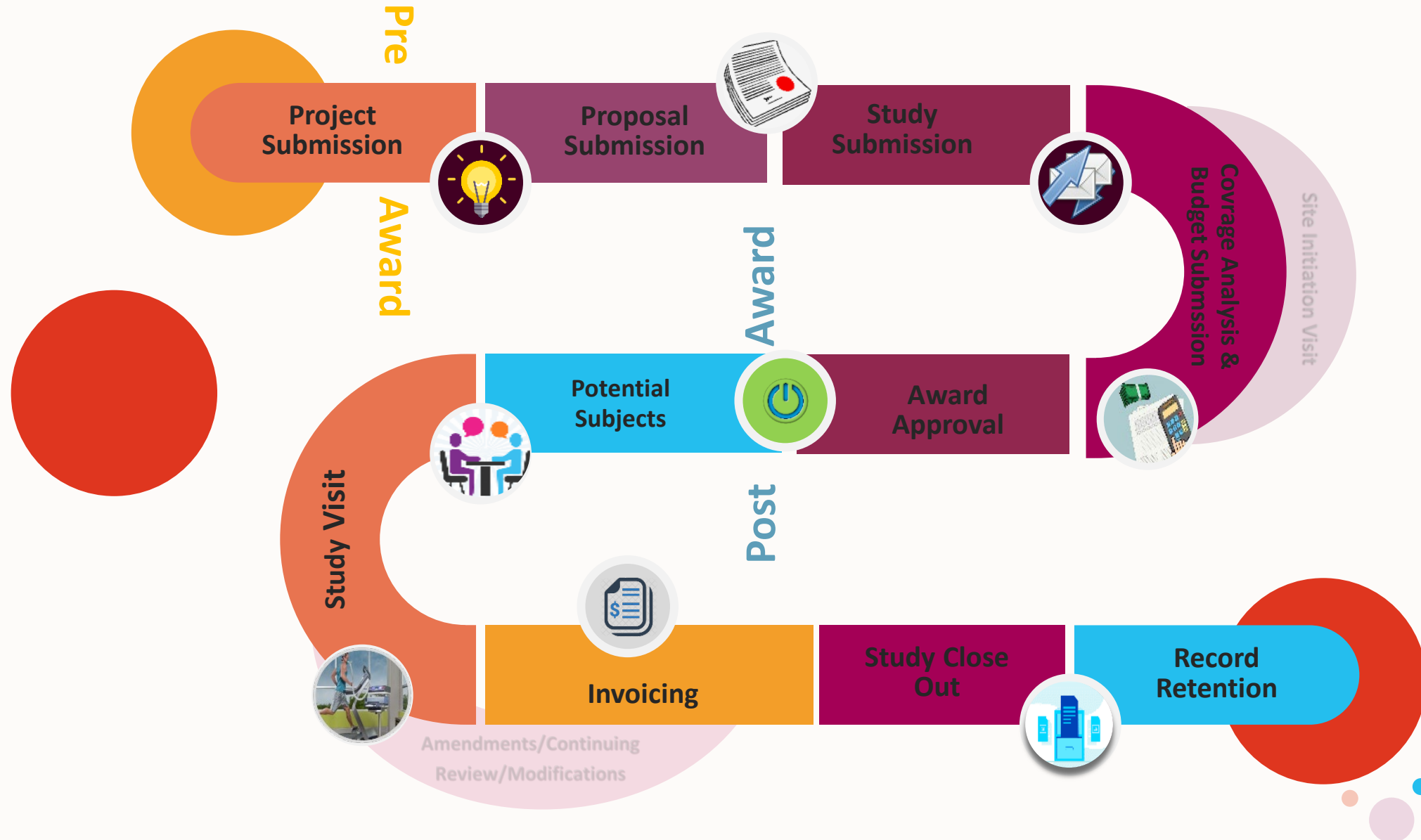


# Clinical Research Roadmap



# Process Meanings

1. Project Submission – Investigator decides to do a trial or has been approached about doing a trial, and submits it for site processing (i.e., Emory University).
2. Proposal Submission – Investigator decides to submit documentation to internal departments.
3. Contract Submission – Investigator initiates funding agreement to internal departments.
4. Study Submission – Investigator/Study Team submits study documents for ethical approval.
5. Coverage Analysis/Budget Submission – Investigator/Study Team submits documents for billing compliance.
6. Award Approval – Internal departments are notified that Emory University accepts the study, budget, and contract for execution.
7. Site Initiation Visit – Investigator/Study Team meets with a study monitor to prepare the site for study initiation.
8. Potential Subjects – Investigator/Study Team recruits subjects per the project's inclusion/exclusion criteria.
9. Study Visit – Investigator/Study Team sees the subject per protocol schedule of events.
10. Invoicing – Internal departments invoice for Study Teams' tracked visits.
11. Study Closeout – Investigator/Study Team notifies Internal departments that all protocol schedule of events are completed.
12. Record Retention – Investigator/Study stores project documents in a secured area/location for certain amount of time per the contract.
